THE REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION

A Republican convention for the state of Oregon is called to meet at the city of Portland, Oregon, on Wednesday, the 3rd day of April, 1884, at 11 o'clock a. m. for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices, to-wit: Representative in congress, judge of the supreme court, the presidential electors, and district judges in the several judicial districts, and to select six delegates to attend the national Republican convention, and to transact such other business as may properly come before the convention.

The convention will consist of 206 delegates, apportioned among the several counties, as follows:

Table listing delegates by county: Baker, 2; Benton, 2; Clatsop, 2; Columbia, 2; Crook, 2; Douglas, 2; Grant, 2; Harney, 2; Josephine, 2; Klamath, 2; Lincoln, 2; Marion, 2; Multnomah, 2; Polk, 2; Tillamook, 2; Washington, 2; Wheeler, 2; Yamhill, 2; Total, 206.

The same being one delegate at large for each county, and one delegate for every 125 voters, and one for every fraction over one-half thereof, cast for Hon. M. C. George, congressman, at the last general election.

The committee earnestly recommend that the delegates elected to the state convention attend in person, and if not convenient for them to so attend personally, that they send their proxies by friendly feeling and permanent residency throughout the state by maintaining a government pledged to these objects and principles, are cordially invited to attend the state convention at the Republican state convention.

A War Reminiscence.

The Milwaukee Sentinel tells a war story how a desperate wounded soldier was shot dead at his own request by a comrade.

Henry J. Savage, one of the soldiers' home veterans, tells the following thrilling story of a war incident: The oft-mooted question, "Was ever a desperately wounded soldier shot dead, at his own earnest solicitation, by a comrade?" is answered in the affirmative as follows: The writer a member of G company, First Delaware Infantry, was then attached to the Third Brigade (Webber's) Third Division (Fry's) Second Corps (Summer). After wading Antietam creek, plunging through plowed fields, stubble fields, and corn fields, his regiment was finally located within plain view of the enemy, when the welcome command rang along the line to "load and fire at will." It was then that our daily routine practice at Fort Monroe came into excellent use, as many a poor devil of the Sixth Alabama pointed to his cost. After firing eleven rounds the writer was wounded and ordered to the rear. While retreating in good order, but making no excellent time, his route led him through a portion of the Irish Brigade. Here we saw a sight that clapped the climax of horror. A member of that devoted brigade was miserably stumbling around with both eyes closed, begging some one, "for the love of God," to put an end to his misery. A lieutenant of the Fourth New York was passing by, and seeing the poor fellow's condition and hearing his appeal, he halted before him and asked him if he really meant what he said.

"Oh, yes, comrade," was his reply, "I cannot possibly live and my agony is unendurable."

With another word the officer drew his pistol, placed it to the victim's right ear, turned away his head and pulled the trigger. A half-wheel, a convulsive gasp, and one more unfortunate and passed over to the silent majority.
