THE REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION.

A Republican convention for the state of Oregon is called to meet at the city of Portland, Oregon, on Wednesday, the 30th day of April, 1884, at 11 o'clock A. M.

The convention will consist of 206 delegates, apportioned among the several counties, as follows:

Table listing delegates by county: Baker, Benton, Clatsop, Columbia, Crook, Curry, Douglas, Grant, Jackson, Josephine, Klamath.

The committee recommend that the primaries be held on Saturday, the 12th of April, and the county conventions on Tuesday, the 22d day of April, unless otherwise ordered by the proper county central committees.

The committee earnestly recommend that the delegates elected to the state convention attend in person, and if not convenient, or if they so desired, personally, that they send their proxies by electors of the county they represent.

The Republican voters of the state, without regard to political differences, who are in favor of elevating and dignifying American labor, giving free popular education to the masses of the people, effectually protecting all human rights in every section of our common country, and who desire to promote friendly feeling and permanent harmony throughout the state by maintaining a government of laws to these objects and principles, are cordially invited to unite in selecting delegates to the Republican state convention.

A Republican county convention for the county of Clatsop is hereby called to meet at the county court house in the city of Astoria, on Wednesday, April 23d, at one o'clock P.
