It must be admitted that Mr. Blaine is not running very well in Great Britain. The newspapers of that country are generally against him; the great manufacturing interests do not view him with favor; and the bankers, merchants and speculators in stocks and produce are disposed, as a rule, to be unfriendly to him.

They do not fear any change in the political relations of the two countries. There is no probability that a war will ever take place between nations so thoroughly resolved to live at peace with each other. Their rivalry is of a sort that puts war out of the question; but it is none the less sharp, determined and important.

For many years past we have been steadily encroaching upon the mother country in the matter of trade, while our products of all kinds have increased and are still increasing at a rate that never had a parallel. Ours is to-day the wealthiest nation on the earth, and it is also the most energetic, progressive and generally forceful and influential.

The position of Mr. Blaine upon this question of the extension of American commerce is very candid and decided. He contends that we should promptly take advantage of every opportunity to enlarge our trade and influence by peaceful means and in accordance with correct business methods.

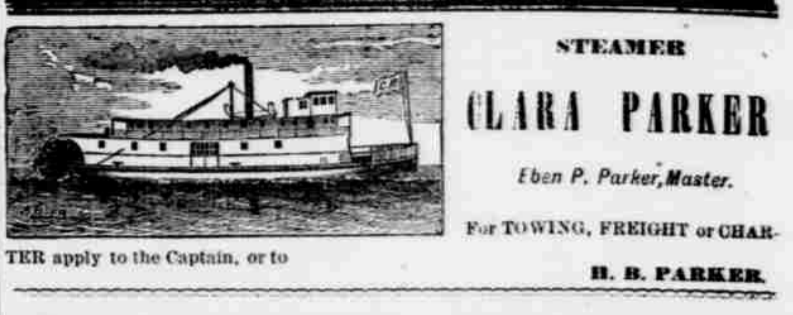
