A Wildcat Fishing.

When the wildcat fishes it is in this sort of way: He leaps from the bank onto a large stone or boulder well out in the stream.

He leaps from the bank onto a large stone or boulder well out in the stream, and assuming a crouching position, waits with the admirable patience so characteristic of his kind.

With whiffling steps toward the boulder, the straight way the eddy is very hungry and happens to miss his aim, he has been seen to dash headlong into the stream, rarely falling in such a case to secure his prey, with which he swims to the nearest bank, and which he straight way begins to eat, beginning at the tail and eating it onwards, bone and all, till not a scale of it remains.
