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An Electric Bed.

The Frankfurter Zeitung relates that the watchmen of the New York fire brigade sleep in electric beds set by the clock, which awakens the sleeper in this manner: Two bells give the first signal for rising, while a lamp near the bed is lighted by electricity. Soon after an invisible power tears the nightcap of the sleeper's head; at the same time a lamp under a coffee urn begins to burn, and further inducement to rise. This proving fruitless, the electric bells sound again, and as a last warning a paper appears at the side of the bed with the word "UP!" imprinted on it. In case of this admonition also proving ineffective, the bed rears itself up on end and simply deposits the occupant on the floor. A specimen of an alarm bed of this kind is at present exhibited at Cassel, in Germany.
