Common Council. REGULAR MEETINGS, SECOND AND FOURTH TUESDAY EVENINGS

Ordinance No. 704. An ordinance concerning disorderly conduct.

The city of Astoria does ordain as follows: Sec. 1.—If any person or persons shall carry any basket or baskets, bucket or buckets, bag or bags or any other thing suspended from or attached to poles across or upon the shoulders, or shall carry any rubbish, garbage, or filth so as to be offensive to pedestrians, upon any sidewalk they shall be liable to a conviction thereof.

Sec. 2.—If any person shall remove, transfer, or transport through any of the public streets of the city of Astoria any soil or garbage, except it be in a tightly covered box or apparatus, or in such a manner as will prevent the contents thereof from being deposited in the open air during such process of transportation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than one nor more than twenty days.

Sec. 3.—If any person or persons shall cut, saw, or split any wood on the sidewalk of any improved street within the city, shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than two nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than one nor more than twenty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 4.—Any person who shall post, place, stamp, paint or otherwise affix or cause to be done by another any notice, placard, bill, poster or advertisement on or upon any sidewalk, crosswalk, curb or curbstone, lamppost, hydrant, shrub or tree, or upon any gate, gate-post, awning, awning-post, horse post, telegraph or telephone poles, or shall post, place, stamp or otherwise affix or cause to be done by another, any notice, placard, bill, poster or advertisement upon any building wall or part thereof without first obtaining permission of the owner, agent or occupant of such premises, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than two nor more than one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than one nor more than twenty days.

Sec. 5.—In case of conviction of any of the offenses mentioned in this ordinance, the court shall judge the offender to pay the costs of prosecution, and shall in default of payment of fine and costs, commit the offender to the city jail for a term of imprisonment not exceeding twenty days, and in all cases where the term of imprisonment in the city jail in lieu of a fine shall not be fixed by the Police Judge the offender shall be imprisoned in default of payment of fine one day for each two dollars of such fine; provided that in no case shall the term of imprisonment exceed a period of twenty days.

Sec. 6.—It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police and the police force to see that the provisions of this ordinance are enforced.
