Proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners of Wahkiakum County, W. T.

NOVEMBER TERM, 1884.
Monday, Nov. 3, 1884.
Present—Jesse Baker, Thomas Irvine and James Wright, commissioners; S. F. Albert, sheriff and C. C. Shepherd, auditor and clerk.

In the matter of the petition presented or signed by fifteen citizens of Deep River, residents of road district No. seven (7) asking that a county road be established as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on navigable water on Deep River at John Wilme's landing and extending to Salmon creek and following the route of the old road, known as the "Old Creek road" and thence through the lands of John Wilme, N. Campbell, J. Salmire and John Davis, to the Salmon creek side of the hill, thence southerly, along the side hill to a point near the house of Simon Keko, where the said road should terminate.
Bond of J. L. Lewis, John Davis and John Salmire, conditioned that they shall pay all costs of viewing, surveying and other expenses connected with the survey and view of the above proposed road, in the event that the said proposed road is not established by the board of county commissioners, examined and approved. And it is hereby ordered that S. P. Hoff, surveyor, John Rull and Lewis Hoff be and are hereby appointed reviewers to meet at the house of John Wilme on Monday, the first day of December, 1884.
Bonds of John Sandstrom and William Thornburg for one thousand dollars each, conditioned that they shall keep quiet and orderly saloons, examined and approved, and license granted to John Sandstrom for the term of six months from and after the third day of October, 1884, by the payment of sixty-two 50-100 dollars and to William Thornburg for the term of six months from and after the 11th day of October, 1884, by the payment of sixty-two 50-100 dollars.
Ordered: Resignation of John Klint, road supervisor of Road District No. Six (6), received and accepted.
Ordered: School District No. Fifteen (15), is hereby established by the county school superintendent and the board of county commissioners, and to be bounded as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the east end of Gray's bay, known as Harrington's point, thence running in a northerly direction along said bay to the mouth of Gray's river, thence east to the east boundary of section No. Thirty, (30), township ten (10) north of range seven (7) west, thence south to the division ridge between Crooked creek and the Columbia river, thence west along said division to the place of beginning.
Ordered: Account of H. M. Bowman, J. P., in the case of Territory of Washington vs. Neil Campbell, allowed in the sum of one hundred and forty-one dollars and eighty cents (\$141.80).
The board adjourned till Wednesday, November 5, at 9 o'clock, A. M.
