There are in the whole country 4,088,807 farms, the value of which is \$10,197,096,774.

PRESIDENT-ELECT Cleveland denies that he ever was president of a free trade club as charged by Hurd, of Ohio.

NORTH CAROLINA is one of the original thirteen states, yet the largest city within its borders has only 20,000 population.

The Oregonian is of the opinion that any member of the state legislature may be a candidate for the United States senate.

It is said that the county of McIntosh, Dakota, that was entirely government land until ninety days ago, does not yet contain men enough to fill the usual offices, but they have elected themselves as far as they will go.

One good authority says that the net result of agriculture in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland for the period from 1873 to the beginning of 1883 was a shrinkage of the aggregate capital of the farmers of the British Isles amounting to \$897,000,000.

A prominent Washington official says that when in New York a few days ago he learned that five physicians had been called in consultation to examine the state of General Grant's health, and arrived at the conclusion that the general was completely broken down, physically and required absolute rest.

CONGRESSMAN GEORGE's views are telegraphed. The legislature meets to-morrow week, and on the 19th proceeds to elect a United States senator. Mr. George is a clever politician, but the people of western Oregon, at least of Clatsop county, would prefer to see their representatives at Salem vote for some one besides Mr. George to represent them for six years in the upper house.

The debt statement shows an increase of the public debt during December of \$641,584; decrease since June 30, 1884, \$31,501,894; cash in the treasury, \$132,276,176; gold certificates, \$119,631,150; silver certificates, \$183,168,291; certificates of deposit, \$21,920,000; refunding certificates, \$290,000; legal tenders, \$31,108,106; fractional currency, \$6,971,343; available cash, \$10,811,923.

Much excitement and surprise has been created in London by the sudden appearance of Gladstone. He hastily called a cabinet which met yesterday. The opinion is that he has received important news of Franco-German designs upon Egypt which require prompt attention. Another rumor is that Germany proposes to follow up her recent acquisitions of islands in the south Pacific, by annexing the Tonga islands and the Samoan or Navigator islands. Still another rumor, which, however, finds little credence, is to the effect that England has agreed to the annexation of the New Hebrides islands by France, on condition that the latter power shall help England out of the Egyptian middle. The statement is that French troops are to be sent into lower Egypt so that the English garrisons may be sent up the Nile if necessary, and that France is to share the burden of interest on the Egyptian debt.

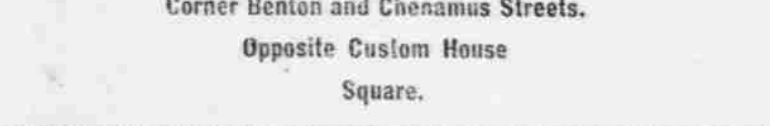

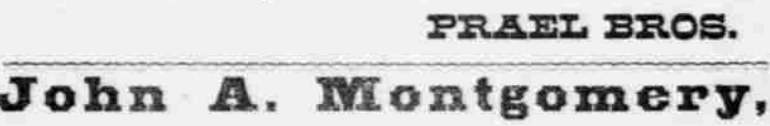

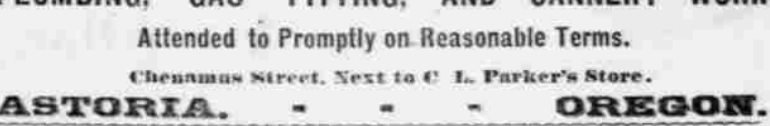
