It Unanimously Adopts a Resolution Advising Improvement of the Columbia.

THE NATIONAL BOARD OF TRADE.
WASHINGTON, Jan. 30. - When the national board of trade resumed its session to-day, a proposition from the Portland board of trade reciting the necessity for the improvement of the Columbia river, was taken up, and Senator Dolph offered the following:
Resolved, That the necessities of commerce demand speedy removal of obstructions to navigation in the Columbia river, and we recommend congress that sufficient appropriations be made to secure completion of the improvements already commenced upon the river and the bar, at the earliest practicable time consistent with an economical expenditure of the appropriations.
Senator Dolph proceeded to set forth the importance of the proposed improvement to the northwest. The improvements of the Columbia river should not be charged to Oregon. It was not a local project, but a plan for rendering navigable a river that drained 200,000 square miles. The valuable products exported from its valley aggregated \$15,870,000 last year.
Mr. Dunham seconded the resolution. He said it would be well if the board could convince members of congress that the people were not in sympathy with their idea of economy. The people were not so solicitous in regard to the question of money. We hear a great deal about the rate of taxation being too high, and that it should be reduced. He did not believe in reducing taxation to such an extent that it would run into niggardly economy. He did not believe in extravagance, and he did not believe in the appropriation of money where there was no necessity for it or where it might be wasted in an extravagant way. He did believe in the interests of this country and people demanded the cheapening of transportation facilities and internal improvements. Economy was a good thing in its way, but niggardly economy was dangerous to the interests of the country. The resolution was unanimously agreed to.

NOT SWAMP LANDS.
Secretary Teller Decides Against the Claims of Oregon.
WASHINGTON, Jan. 31. - Recently the general land office of Oregon appealed from the commissioner's decision rejecting its claim to about 48,000 acres of alleged swamp land, chiefly on the ground that no testimony had been submitted as to the character of the land under its action and that its claims should be so determined, according to the original plan agreed upon by the state and the secretary of the interior. Secretary Teller to-day affirms the commissioner's decision in the main, for the reason that the state had waived this plan by the substitution of another; that the character of the lands should be determined by a joint report of its agent, an agent of the United States, specially deputized to examine and report upon the lands, and that under such reports the lands in question were not swamp or overflowed lands and did not inure to the state. But as there was some question as to the character of about 1500 acres of the 48,000 Secretary Teller modifies Commissioner McFarland's decision and directs that a new examination be made of the tracts by agents of the United States and state of Oregon, and if they concur in their conclusions, that the same shall conclude the question, but that they do not concur, then that hearings be held and the character of the lands be determined by testimony.

Case of Emperor William's Sickness.
LONDON, Jan. 31. - Truth claims to have positive information that the present serious illness of the German emperor, is due to the imprudence of a heavy meal of hot lobsters washed down with Rhine wine, occasioning indigestion, and his heroic remedies producing weakness. Truth adds: The Kaiser's taste is coarse. His favorite dishes are fish and soup, in which cider and pickled cucumbers also are hashed, veal flavored with cinnamon and cloves, and also sponge cake steeped in pineapple rum.
