On the 4th of March, 1861, the Republican party assumed administrative control of the Union; the first four years of its existence were consumed in a civil war; the twenty succeeding years have been years of peace, of plenty, of material progress.

To-day the Democratic party assumes administrative control of the affairs of the country. 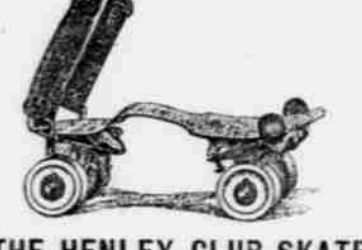
