As English official estimate shows the expenses of the Sudan campaign to the end of February to be \$3,360,000.

THE gross earnings of the Northern Pacific railroad for February are reported at \$569,562, an increase over February last year of \$49,477.

LONDONERS learn with astonishment that Germany proposes to take possession of a territory in eastern Africa, covering an area more than twice the size of Prussia.

SAYS the St. Louis Globe Democrat: "It is gratifying to know that Schwatka's resignation from the army is due to the fact that the government would not allow him to carry on explorations for the benefit of Oregon capitalists."

THE Union metallic cartridge company, of Bridgeport, Conn., has received an order for 50,000,000 cartridges from the English government, and 100,000,000 from Russia. These are the largest single orders ever received by any firm in the world.

ENGLAND is in universal trouble. Even on her Persian frontier there is discontent. A dispatch from Teheran states the insurgent native chiefs of India have already raised the fiery cross and proclaimed in favor of Russia. St. Petersburg newspapers warn the English government that the malicious designs of Bismarck will cause a rupture between England and Russia.

THE press of the country is still discussing the failure of our legislature to elect a senator. Many refuse to believe it and insist that it is a mistake. The thing may encourage immigration. Curious people may come out here to see what kind of a state it is where 52 Republicans in a legislature of 90 members are unable to elect a senator to represent his state in the national capitol.

A WISCONSIN special says that farmers of the province are in session there. Many accessions are being received to the ranks of the secessionists and annexationists. Resolutions were passed denouncing Premier Norquay for failing to secure concessions from the dominion government, calling for redistribution of seats and appealing to the country. An uprising is really feared.

On the 5th, President Cleveland sent to the senate the following nominations: Secretary of state, Thomas F. Bayard of Delaware; secretary of the treasury, Daniel Manning of New York; secretary of War, William E. Endicott of Massachusetts; secretary of the navy, William C. Whitney of New York; secretary of the interior, L. Q. C. Lamar of Mississippi; postmaster-general, William F. Vilas of Wisconsin; attorney-general, A. H. Garland, of Arkansas. Bayard and Lamar are statesmen; the rest of the cabinet have a splendid record to make.
