A Work of Art.

One of the neatest and most elaborately inished Writing Desks ever seen on this coast can be seen on exhibition in the win flow of the eigar store, next to Foster's Exchange, on Water street in this city. The lesk was made by Mr. C. Constantine of this city and certainty reflects great credit on the skill, taste and workmanship of the manufacturer.
