



A report has been received that while a detach-ment of mounted police was proceed ing to reinforce Fort Carleton, insur-gents attacked it, killing fifteen of the police and wounding others. An-other report has been circulated that field has been shot. The rebels have captured and imprisoned forty whites and have taken possession of more stores. Four Indian chiefs and bands have joined the insurgents, who now number over 100 hardy men, all well armed. A dispatch from Edmonton to the Hudson bay company says 400 half breeds located in that vicinity are holding secret meetings and or ganizing for action. The insurgents have seized several private stores and re meancing the Hudson bay com-pany's trading posts. General Mid-dleton, commander-in-chief of the Canadian militia, will arrive Thress day to take command of the expedi-tion. 
