A YANKEE MONARCH. Interesting Career of Albert Steinberger, the Only American Who Was Ever Made King.

EALE PASS, TEX., May 5. "Hello, here's a letter from an ex-king," said Col. John A. Steinberger one morning as the mail boy laid his packet fresh from the postoffice on my office desk.

By way of introduction let it be stated that the portly colonel is at present engaged in the responsible and lucrative position of superintendent of all the coal mines of the Southern Pacific railroad, and his duties call him from Washington Territory's joy mountains to the scorching plains of tropical Mexico. He is a well-preserved man of 55, and bears his honors easily.

Albert gradually rose into position until he was asked to become premier to royalty itself, which was represented at that time by his dusky highness, King Malton, a superb specimen of a physical man, cunning and crafty as an old fox, but honorable and worshipped by his subjects.
