A PERILOUS TRIP.

Exciting Ride Over the Kootenai Rapids in a Bateau. The following story was told to a Statesman reporter by W. H. Toles.

The following story was told to a Statesman reporter by W. H. Toles, who had just made the run of the Columbia river from the line of the Canadian Pacific to the Little Dalles.

The first twenty-five miles was passed without any event worth mentioning. As the boat was gliding along rapidly in comparatively smooth but swift water a snag was suddenly encountered.

Once through the lakes the Kootenai rapids were reached and there the fun commenced. The immense body of water flowing down the Columbia was here compressed through a narrow rocky gorge.

For an instant was told to sight, then again emerging into view it was shot like an arrow down stream, narrowly escaping being thrown on an ominous-looking boulder projecting from the water in mid-stream.

The exhausted boatmen hoped for rest, but were to be disappointed, for the water begins to describe a circle.

The whirlpool is filling and a moment's delay on the spot means death. The bateau and its precious cargo will be sucked into the now troublesome vortex and all will be lost.

By the escape of its prey, holed and wrecked and whirled in its seemingly frantic attempts to swamp its prey.

The entire forty-two miles of the Kootenai rapids was a repetition of such scenes, but the gallant crew destined to an accident on the first day, were also destined to pass safely by the rapids, which mean almost death to pass over in a frail bateau.
