

2d. A woman who marries after making a settlement and filing, and prior entry, forfeits her pre-emption right. (Chamberin vs. Drucker, Secretary, July 28, 1885.)

A pre-emptor of land in one county having become an officer in another county under a law requir-ing him to be an inhabitant of such county, is estopped from asserting a residence on said claim during the term of office. Circular of April 22, 1885, erroneous in requiring claimants at hearings upon their perfected entries to submit their testimony first, subject to cross-examination and rebuttal (Ex parte Burns, See'y,

July 25, 1885.)

If widow of decased entryman remarries before final proof, the certificate should be made out in her present name and describe her as formely the widow of the deceased, naming him. (Ex parte Hingst Commissioner, July 29, 1885.)

We regret that the government should send back a band of Indians, formerly known as "hostiles," but now characterized by the government as "good" Indians. But their atrocious work is a matter of the past and we do not seem to make progress in reviving the story of their crime. They readily understand that in case of an outbreak or any attempt of the kind, they would be met by a thousand armed settlers ready to put down such insurrection. Hence there is no apparent inclination among these Indians to barm the white peo ple or to agitate sedition in any form. There is and has been no fear on the part of the settlers in this locality on secount of Indians.-Lewiston, Ida-
