

An official at Washington who has been engaged in counting the money in the treasury vaults furnishes some in the treasury vanits turmsuces interesting information about the amount and weight thereof. There are \$9.000,000 in silver in bags each Pimples to Scrofula. and three ounces, so \$100,000 in silver would pull down the balance at almost three tons, and \$1,000,000 would be nearly 60,000 pounds. The entire amount of coined silver now in the treasury vaults it is estimated, will weigh 543,700 pounds. A pound of gold coin weighs \$240, and \$480,000 of it weighs a ton. There are nearly twelve tons of gold fives, tens and twentys in the country's strong box at the tree. at the treasury. Of the paper money, could be made of the United States currency now in the vaults and in circulation. The money of coarse is not counted coin by coin. The gold and silver are weighed very carfully on the finest and most carefully fitted scales that were ever made. Though 1,000 pounds can be weighed at a time, a pin placed on the balance will tip it.
