

SEATTLE, Sept. 9.—The latest news from Squak, the scene of the attack on the Chinese hop pickers on Monday night, is that the attack was made by white men and not by Indians as previously reported. The first intimation which the Chinamen had of the presence of the enemy was a volley of shots from rifles and revolvers fired directly into their tents. The attacking party numbered about ten. Three Chinamen were killed outright and four wounded. Most of those who succeeded in escaping made their way through the woods to Newcastle, and were brought to this city by train. They are all greatly terrified at the outrage. The attempt to introduce Chinese labor in the Squak hop fields has been given up, and the remaining Chinese will be brought to this city as rapidly as possible.
