#### Purifying Water by Motion,

Dr. Pehl, of St. Petersburg, claims to have made the important discovery that motion destroys the impurities of water. At a test when water was brought into rapid motion for an hour by means of a centrifugal machine the number of developing germs was reduced by ninety per cent. Further experiments will show if this destruction of germs is due to the motion of the mass of water or to molecular motion. If this discovery of Dr. Pehl's be confirmed, it will become possible to destroy bacteria and ren-der water comparatively pure simply by passing it through a centrifugal machine.
