Genuine perique tobacco only grows on a ridge situated about one mile from the Mississippi river, in St. James' Parish, Louisiana, and said ridge is only about two miles wide and seven miles in length. Tobacco will grow in any part of the State, but it is on this patch only that the famous perique is cultivated. The average crop is 75,000 pounds.

A Zereba.

The zereba is a native light Barricade constructed in the form of a square, and, by the Arabs, made of mimoso brush, piled with the prickly branches outward, and built high enough to make the offer to overleap them is practicable. The sharp, jagged branches present a forbidding aspect to the Arabs and blacks, who have no taste for flinging their naked bodies against them. The great factics of the Arabs is to attack by "rushing." in the hope to overwhelm by the very impetus of the assault, the waiting enemy. As a means of checking this "rush" the zereba has been found very effective, and the English adopted the native example as a very excellent provision against a decisive charge from the enemy in open fighting. But any sort of super-ficial fortification flung up to meet a temporary requirement is now re-ferred to in the dispatches as a zereba. It corresponds, in fact, to the feucerail breastworks and the light earthworks thrown [up by our own troops in the war of the Union. The principle of construction is a very old one, and is a very good one in primi-tive warfare where the serious fight-

ing is in hand-to-hand encounters.
