Frankland's experi ments have shown that the best filters for drinking water are made of green sand, coke, animal charcoal, or spongy iron, but in every case the filter loses its power to remove all organic particles after being used a month

A geological commission has been appointed by the Spanish Government to investigate the Philippines. The geography and topography of the Archipelago will be studied, as well as the geology, and a map will be prepared to complete and correct existing ones.

A disease known in Caylon as kakke or beriberi has been investigated by Dr. W. Taylor, of Osaka, Japan, and traced to a microscopic spore, which is often found largely developed in rice, and has been detected in the earth of certain alluvial and demp localities. and damp localities.

According to Henry Vivarez, a French electrician, silicious bronze has a conductibility comparable to that of copper, and a strength greater than that of iron. For telegraphic purposes silicious bronze wires may be used to replace those of galvanized iron more than five times as heavy.

Prof. A. Landmark, chief director of the Norwegian Fisheries, finds that, under favorable conditions, a salmon may sometimes jump sixteen feet perpendicularly, and that when the fish's lesp is a foot or two short of the waterfall, it often succeeds in completing the ascent by a dexterous use of the tail.

The retina of the living eye has been photographed by two English operators. Owing to the non-actinic color of the retina, an exposure of twenty minutes by gaslight was required with an extra sensitive gelatine plate. Although small, the negative shows the bifurcation of the blood-vessels, and also the edge of the blind spot.

From experiments in tropical Africa, Herman Soyaux concludes that agriculture is practicable, the soil—though exhausted in a year by maize and manise—being suitable for the cultivation of coffee, vanilla. India rubber, tobacco, cetton, and sugar-cane. In the Upper Congo country these plants and many others grow naturally or are already cultivated.
