The special work ac-complished with it this year has consisted in the photometric observa-tions of the satellites of Jupiter, the revision of zone observations, the measurement of the light of stars to obtain magnitudes, the computation of the orbits of comets, the observations of the color of stars, and of the stellar spectra.-[Cleveland Leader.
