Scientific Miscellany.

During all seasons of the year, it is said, the earth at Yakutsk, Siberia, Skin Diseases instantly Reis frozen from the depth of fifty feet to that of about 1,000 feet.

The increase of suicide is scientifically ascribed to the fastness of modern life, to forced education, and to the increasing difficulty of exist-Small-pox was accurately described

by Rhazes, an Arabian physician, about 900 A. D. It is supposed to have been introduced into Europe by the Saracens, and it was spread widely among the Indians by the early explorers of America. A remarkable specimen lately ex-hibited to the London Zoological

Society was a Brazilian snake which had partly swallowed a live lizard. The lizard had nearly succeeded in eating its way out, through the body of the snake, when death overtook both creatures.

The salts of sea-water, according to Prof. W. C. Williamson, F. R. S., are rendered inert by the addition of citrate of silver, an ounce of that substance converting half a pint of sea-water into a drinkable fluid. It is proposed to pack citrate of silver in the life-boats of ocean-going ves-sels for use in case of need.

That earthquakes exert a destructive influence on the phyloxera insect of the grape is the opinion of S. Villalongue, who has told the Paris Academy of Sciences of a vineyard near Malaga which had apparently been destroyed by the parasite, but which vigorously burst into leaf after the recent earthquakes in southern Spain.

Prof. Tromholt, in Norway, has met with partial success in photo-graphing the aurora borealis, a feat which his many failures had led him to pronounce impossible. After exposing a plate for eight and a half minutes, he secured a negative of an aurora, but the impression is so very faint that it cannot be reproduced as a positive.

Dr. C. E. Saunders, of the West Herts Medical Association in England, contends that cholera is transmitted from one locality to another by human agencies rather than cli-matic causes. Evidence of this is the fact that no outbreak has been known to occur in less time than it would take a man to travel the distance from the nearest place where

the disease already existed. The seeds of the Kola tree, the highly prized stimulant of the na-tives of Africa, appear to possess qualities which should give them a commercial value in civilized countries. Mr. T. Christie, an English writer on new commercial plants and drugs, asserts that choco-late made with Kola peste is ten times as nutritions as that made with cocoa, and that a laborer car work all day without fatigue on a single cup taken at breakfast time.

A living species of four-footed bird, inhabiting the island of Marajo in the Lower Amazons, was a short time ago described by Mr. E. M. Brigham. It is only during infancy that the remarkable feature of this bird is seen, the two fore-feet appearing early in the development of the embryo and continuing parfectly formed for several days after
