Industrial and Business.

India now produces annually 7,000,000 tons of wheat.

The South Florida Railroad has established a hospital at Sanford to be used by their employes in case of sickness or accident, each one being taxed 50 cents per month.

According to the views of a number of men in the rubber business, the factories of the United States could easily double their yearly production without increasing their plant.

Rolls of paper nine miles long, says the Mechanical Engineer, have been made from reground wood-pulp. At some of the wood-pulp mills rolls four miles long are made regularly.

The house-builders are busy in every section of the city and in all the suburban cities and towns. And in many places new houses are bespoken for purchase or rent as soon as the foundations are laid.—Boston Traveller.

In the counties of northern Illinois the wages of farm laborers the present season average \$1 with board, \$1.25 without board, \$19.50 per month with board, and \$27.75 without board. Wages are lower in the central and southern portions of the State.

The culture of hemp has been revived in central Illinois the present season. The fiber is to be sold to the manufacturers of twine for self-binding. It is thought that the demand for hemp for this purpose will cause this crop to be extensively raised in the future.

The London Statist is not surprised that American railways are not making money, and describes them as "a magnificent property being eaten to death by parasites of every description." Everybody connected with them is making money, while the shareholders, and sometimes the bondholders, are sent away empty.

The growth of some of the Southern States is illustrated by the statement concerning Clattanoga that it has increased since the war "from a clump of whitewashed ware-houses and shanties to a city of 25,000 inhabitants; from a tax-roll of \$1,300,000 to one of \$7,000,000; and has increased its business capital from \$209,000 to \$5,000,000.
