#### A Wonderful Orchestra.

There is a nightly concert in the lower part of Alleghamy by the larg-est orchestra in the world. It is composed of at least 300 players, who perform on nearly every known in-strument. The musicians play what they please; they never see each other while they play, and their audience consists of the same people at every performance. The concert begins at precisely 6 o'clock every evening, and ends at the stroke of 7. #### Some Peculiar Effects of Sea Salt.

A correspondent on one of the islands of the Gulf of Mexico writes: The Cheniere, as well as Grand Isle, was once a sugar plantation, but the force of constant winds, blowing from one point of the compass, has several times caused the rollers to sweep across it for many days, and this, added possibly to transpiration water, after a time made the saccharine juice more salt than sweet. The residents are obliged to either use the wood drifted in upon the waves or bring it in lug-gers from a distance. As the salt in the drift wood rusts and destroys the cooking stoves there are none in use on the island. But if the meals are cooked upon an iron frame in a great, wide-mouthed fireplace, they lose none of their savoriness thereby.


