Should it look up from its slumbers, the bear remains as motionless as a piece of ice, for which he hopes to be taken his head down again, when he once more commences "hitching" for-ward. By this series of very slow and laborious creepings, he manages to get within ten or twenty feet of his victim, when, watching his best
