He thundered, he roared, he whooped he howled, he jarred the windows, he sawed the air, he split the horizon with his clarion notes, he tipped over the table, kicked the lamps out of the chandeliers, and smashed the big bass viol over the chief fiddler's

Oh, Demosthenes was business when he got started. It will be along time before we see another off-hand speaker like Demosthenes, and I, for one, have never been the same man since I learned of his death.

One hundred and ten years ago Patrick Henry said: "Sir, our chains are forged. Their clanking may be heard on the plains of Boston. The war is inevitable, and let it come. I epeat it, sir, let it come!"
