Oregon Hops.
There is nothing doing in hops in local markets, even in Portland and San Francisco markets no quotations being made. A shipment of 223 bales was made down the river from the Santiam warehouse below Jefferson recently to Meyer & Co. of Portland, to await better prices. Eastern exchanges state that brewers' wants are well supplied, and all kinds except strictly choice hops are dull sale. Very fine Bavarian recently sold in the New York market at 22 and 25 cents per pound, and some as low as 18 cents, in a moderate way. Reports had circulation at 14 cents. New York state 1885's sold at 9 to 10 cents, and as low as 7 cents was accepted for 1884's. Pacific 1886's and Washington territory were offered at 24 to 25 cents, and California as low as 20 cents.—*Albany Herald.*
