### Logging Railways.

The importance of the logging railway is strikingly illustrated in the statistical exhibit which may be found in detail on pages 97 to 108 of this paper. The total number of such roads from which the *Lumberman* has received reports reaches the surprising total of 383. There are undoubtedly several which have been omitted, as the American forests constitute a pretty big piece of woods in which to go hunting for logging railroads. The information given in the detailed reports will prove of great value to all interested in this method of logging, either as builders or users. In only one instance has the information asked for by the *Lumberman* been refused, and that in a quarter and by a concern from which such refusal was least expected.

Not less astonishing than the total of the number of roads are the figures showing their annual hauling capacity as given in the following tabulated statement:

The foregoing footings include only the roads for which the annual capacity was stated. Although the number which did not report upon that particular point is small, it would swell the grand total several million feet, to more than four billions, at least.

Michigan, of course, leads the list in number of roads, mileage and hauling capacity. The singular part of the showing, is that Pennsylvania stands next, having 43 roads to Michigan's 53. In mileage and hauling capacity its totals are considerably less, but the fact that Pennsylvania has enough logging railroads to haul 367,000,000 feet annually will be more or less of a surprise to most people. — *Northwestern Lumberman.*

### Kitchen Help.

One of the topics that vex and bother people at the present day is the procuring of efficient and reliable help in the kitchen and domestic departments of American households. The editor of the *Helping Hand* says that concessions must be made to servant girls. One who signs herself as "Only a Servant Girl," in commenting on this editor's remarks, emphatically avers that the only concession that will help the matter is to raise the grade of domestic service. She says: "Men and women may write and scold and fret about the servant girl topic until the crack of doom, and every year the difficulty will increase until work in the kitchen and in the bedroom is thought no more dishonorable in itself than work behind the counter, at the piano, at the desk, in the school room, in the editorial room, in authorship or the learned professions. It is all work—all done to make a 'living'—all honorable if well done. Even the hod carrier and the street paver have a reasonable amount of consideration, if, after their work is done they can put on the clothes and the manners of gentlemen and talk as intelligently as the average of men and women about them. But the servant girls, good clothes, good manners or good sense are no passport to any society outside of her own set. The evil will be cured when the cause is removed. It is not fear of work which causes the bright but needy American girl to shun domestic service, but it is dread, fear and abhorrence of the caste feeling which puts its mark on all those who engage in it."
