Big Sterm on the Canadian Pacific.

WINNIPEG, Feb. 4.-The storm which has prevailed in the northwest for some days has somewhat abated, but there is still a great blockade. The storm is the worst ever experienced in the la-tory of the Canadian Pacific railroad. In the mountains many cattle have been destroyed.

The Nase! boom broke loose Sunday night and allowed some 400,000 feet of logs to go adrift. It is thought that the greater portion of them can be recovered, and the steamer Custer has been employed the fore part of the week picking up. The high water caused the break, and the piles holding the boom sticks were pulled out or broken off with the force of water. The river is bank full and is likely to overflow. 
