Bismarck and the Pope.

BRESLAU, Feb. 8.—It is stated that Monsignor Kopp, Catholic bishop of Fulda, who mediated between Prussia and the Vatican in the negotiations for revision of the May laws, has been deputed by the pope to make a statement declaring the pope's intention of advising Catholic electors to support the government on the septennate bill, and explaining papal interests from the Catholic standpoint in having Catholic electors assist in securing the success of Prince Bismarck's bill in the reichstag.

The occasion for making this important statement will be the introduction in the upper house of the Prussian diet of the new ecclesiastical bill. It is also announced here that the pope, desiring to meet Prussia's views even in the matter of ecclesiastical discipline and appointment, will favor the nomination of Dr. Kopp to the bishopric of Breslau.
