Recommendations of Appropriations.

SALEM, Feb. 13.—The house committees on public buildings made the following recommendations yesterday:

That at the penitentiary a brick building, to be used as a laundry, blacksmith and work shop, be erected at a cost of \$6,250; that a brick addition be erected at the south end of the main building, for a hospital and dining room, to cost \$1,000. They also recommended an expenditure of \$1,500 for fire hydrants and hose, \$2,500 for a brick machine and other appliances in the brick yard, and from \$4,000 to \$7,000 for a brick or iron wall for the better protection of the main building.

For the asylum they recommended an appropriation of \$4,925 for the erection of a new wing, perfecting the water system, wainscoting and other improvements.

For the blind school they recommended an appropriation of \$2,000 for establishing an industrial department, for sewerage and furnishing and repairing the building.

For the capitol, \$40,000 for furnishing rooms, finishing the building, completion of porticos, purchase and placement of elevators, and for other repairs and improvements to the building and grounds.

Marine Hospital Service.

The annual report of the supervising surgeon-general of the United States shows that during the year ending June 30, 1886, the total number of seamen treated in the hospital at Portland was 294, Astoria 52, Port Townsend 402, Tacoma 7. Number of days relief in hospital—Portland, 2,929; Astoria, 1,339; Port Townsend, 4,961; Tacoma, 65. Amount expended—Portland, \$4,137; Astoria, \$1,406; Port Townsend, \$5,525; Tacoma, not reported.

For the year ending June 30, 1887, contracts have been entered into between the government and private hospitals as follows:

At Portland—The medical attendance to be furnished by a medical officer of the marine hospital service; St. Vincent's hospital to furnish quarters, subsistence, nursing and medicines at 60 cents per day, and to provide for the burial of deceased patients at \$15 each. Out-patients to be treated at the dispensary, room 21, Union block. At Astoria—Saint Mary's hospital to furnish quarters, subsistence, nursing, medical attendance and medicines, at \$1 per day. Port Townsend—Patients cared for in the United States marine hospital. John Heackwell to provide for the burial of deceased patients at \$12 each. At Tacoma—Fannie C. Paddock Memorial hospital to furnish quarters, subsistence, nursing, medical attendance and medicines at \$1 per day.
