**That Terrible North Coast.**  
SEATTLE, April 3.—Charles Baker, a longshoreman on the ill-fated *Mexico*, makes the following statement: There were twenty-three longshoremen from Seattle aboard, and counting the officers and crew the steamer had 102 persons all told. She left Nainaimo about 7 o'clock in the evening coal laden for Seattle. I had turned in about fifteen minutes when the ship struck. I first thought it was a collision, but going on deck found the bow well up on the rock. I saw the tug *Alexander* towing the ship *Carlin* to sea. Judging from her course our ship must have been at least five miles out of her course. The weather was very thick and stormy. We went on the rocks about a quarter to one o'clock Thursday morning. The concussion threw me out of my bunk. I think we were going about 12 knots an hour. The place we struck was nearly opposite Roberts Point. We fired a cannon, signaling assistance and were taken by the *Princess Louise* to Victoria. All the longshoremen and a part of the crew were taken from the ship yesterday. The captain was in charge, I think, up to 12 or half-past. We had passed through Plumper pass. There were no boats lowered until 9 o'clock Friday morning. The pilot is considered a very good one. This I know, for I have been up that way a great many times.

**HISTORY OF THE VESSEL.**  
The *Mexico* is an American screw steamer, hailing from New York, built in San Francisco in 1881 by Dickie Bros. and strongly constructed, of yellow fir, iron and copper fastenings; length 274 feet, beam 26 feet, depth of hold 20.5 feet. At the last survey, held in San Francisco March, 1882, her registered tonnage was 1,341, gross 1,797; 220 horse power engines. The vessel was built and intended for the Mexican trade originally between San Francisco and Panama. The owners, Birmingham & Hartshorn, of San Francisco, finding she was too large a vessel to be profitable on that route, chartered her to the Pacific Coast Steamship company for \$200 per day. She has run in the trade between San Francisco and southern ports ever since. She was probably insured pretty near her value. She was worth about \$260,000. Capt. Huntington has been in her ever since she was built. She is one of the finest steamships on the Pacific coast, and the company's agents here have telegraphed Goodall, Perkins & Co., San Francisco agents, for instructions. The steamship *Unatilla*, Capt. D. O. Blackburn, will take the freight which was intended for the *Mexico* to San Francisco. She would also take passengers but is not fitted for passenger traffic.

It is now conceded by many that ten pounds of good pressed hay is equivalent to about thirteen pounds of loose hay. The storage space for a given number of tons is also much to the credit of pressed hay. There is a great need of a machine that is cheap enough in price to be within reach of a farmer, to be used for baling an ordinary crop of hay for his own use.

**Asked to Vote as They Fought.**  
CHICAGO, April 3.—A remarkable spectacle, the like of which was never before witnessed in an American city, was presented Saturday night at the headquarters of the Chicago police department. The officers of the central detail were quietly standing in ranks for roll call, when their highest superior, chief of police Frederick T. Ebersold, entered the guard room. He spoke a few words in an undertone to Lieut. Fitzpatrick, and then in a voice full of suppressed feeling, addressing the ranks said: "Men, next Tuesday I want you to remember the 4th of May. Think of the men who threw the bomb and killed your comrades when you put in your votes—and vote, every one of you!—vote for law and order. There is no politics in this fight. It is for good government; it is against anarchy; it is for law and order." The blue-coated auditors scarcely breathe. With eyes strained hard and teeth clinched they stood as motionless and silent as stone. When the chief ceased, the order to break ranks was unheeded for a moment—not a man stirred. Then, regardless of the imperative rule requiring them to go at once to their beats, the stalwart men in blue crowded around the speaker, exclaiming: "We will; we will!" "That's right; it's against anarchy." Chief Ebersold seemed much agitated, and gave each of the men a warm word or encouraging look, as they hurriedly withdrew to their duty.

Several well-known politicians and newspaper men were talking together in a New York hotel, recently.
