I was chatting the other day with the vice president of one of the trunk lines of railway, when a messenger entered with an important contract, having twentyone years to run. It was a traffic agreement with a competing line, and was a very valuable doc-ument. It happened to be written with a typewriter in aniline ink. The result was the return of the contract, with a request that hereafter all important documents, the preservation of which is desirable, should be written in ink that would not fade.

He had at once issued an order forbidding its use in the department, purchased a new set of books, into which two years' records were copied, and thus saved what in a few years would have been lost. 
