From the Oregon Code.

Section 670. If any person shall, by any use of force, threats or intimidation, prevent or endeavor to prevent any person employed by another from continging or performing his work, or from accepting any new work or employment, or if any person shall, by the use of like means, prevent another from employing any person or to compel another to employ any person, or to force or induce another to alter his mode of carrying on business, or to limit or increase the number of persons employed by him, or their rate of in the county jail not less than one month, nor more than six months, or by fine not less than twenty nor more than three hundred dollars.


