

Strengthening the Fleet.

LONDON May 2.-The admiralty has advices from the north Pacific station to-night, and reports that the Russian fleet in the Pacific is being constantly reinforced. During the past two weeks three steam schooners partly armored one ironclad and several dispatch vessels and torpedoes, have arrived, together with two troop ships, each bringing one battalion at full war strength. The British fleet in the north Pacific is about to be strengthened by the addition of ships of a more powerful Ship Chandlers, type than those at present on the stations.
