Officed Too Soon.

VINCENNES, Ind., May 9.—During the session of the Lutheran Evangelical Synod at Booneville, Philip Greig, a wealthy citizen of Mount Auburn, who was present as a delegate, fell, as was supposed, dead from apoplexy. The remains were hurriedly prepared for burial and shipped to the home of the deceased. Ten hours after the supposed death the remains arrived here. The baggage man who had handled the coffin related that he had heard the dead man kick against the box three or four times and that it did not handle like a dead weight. Word was sent to the chief of police at Cincinnati and information had been telegraphed that on the coffin being opened the man was found lying on his face, his shroud was torn to shreds and there were other indications to show that he had come to life after being placed in the coffin.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 9.—
