**The Session Laws.**  
SALEM, May 16—The state printer finished printing the session laws to-day, five days before the expiration of the time allowed by law, and they were delivered to the binder this afternoon. The laws make a volume of 450 pages, and the typographical work is excellent throughout. From 1859 until 1878 the state printer was required to bind the laws within ninety days after adjournment of the legislature, but since 1878 the binding has been under the control of the secretary of state, no time being prescribed within which it should be completed. To meet a general wish that the laws shall be ready for distribution by the time when they take effect, all other state work has been laid aside at the bindery, and the binding of the laws has already begun. Secretary McBride says he expects to deliver a copy to every circuit and county court by May 21st, and will distribute the remaining copies every few days, as fast as they are bound. The public officers will be supplied before any copies will be sold to private persons. The senate journal index will be printed this week, and the printing of the house journal will then be begun.
