





lands to be restored, are given in the order of the interests involved as follows: Northern Pacific railway in Montana, Dakota, Wash-ington territory, Idaho and Ore-

gon; Atlantic & Pacific, in New Mexico west of the Rio Grande, and Arizona; the Southern Pacific.


