

The Ohio man is in the field for a nomination to the presidency. He has always been a lucky man in politics. Thurman was tendered the office of interstate commissioner, but declined. John Sherman has placed himself on the track for a presidential nomination from the Republican party.

Stranger things have happened than that John Sherman should receive the next presidential nomination. Sherman is an adroit politician, and he has the advantage of a very good political record. The additional advantage is that his brother, Gen. W. T. Sherman, a nominal Democrat, who has declared over and over again that he would not accept any political nomination, is working quietly for John.

This is the possible new phase of politics. It is not assumed that Blaine's political nose is to be put out of joint, only that he has a formidable rival in Sherman, who has loomed up in Ohio and elsewhere, and is to make a determined effort for the nomination. He was the candidate seven years ago at Chicago when Garfield received the nomination.

At this date the Democrats have no very prominent candidate, or, rather, they have not brought forward any one who attracts much attention, unless it may be President Cleveland. There is Randall of Pennsylvania, Carlisle of Kentucky, and Hoadly of Ohio, who has become a citizen of New York.

It does not appear that ex-governor Hoadly is going to New York ostensibly to practice law, is going out of politics. In short, he appears to be much inclined to kindle a fresh fire in the political furnace. The ex-governor is going to stand by Cleveland, and the

natural inference is that the latter is going to stand by Hoadly.

The steamer Umbria has broken the record between Queenstown and Sandy Hook. She left Liverpool at 2 o'clock in the afternoon of May 28th, passed out of Queenstown harbor at 1:04 o'clock May 29th, anchored off bar Sandy Hook at 12:43 last Monday afternoon, thus making the run from Queenstown in six days, four hours and two minutes. The weather was usually favorable. The Umbria made the best record heretofore in six days five hours and thirty-six minutes.

FRANCE appropriates \$1,627,500 a year in maintaining vast horse-breeding establishments chiefly to recruit her army horse. This sum was reduced last year to \$1,348,600 by the hire of stallions. For the same purpose Austria-Hungary spends \$1,000,000 a year and Prussia spends \$400,000 on the royal breeding establishments, besides which there are fifteen other depots maintained at a corresponding cost.

Ex-Gov. HOADLY writes that he "cannot consent" to the use of his name as a candidate for the vacancy on the supreme bench, and expresses his hope and belief that "the appointment will go south, to some Democratic lawyer who believes that the constitution is in writing and means what it says."

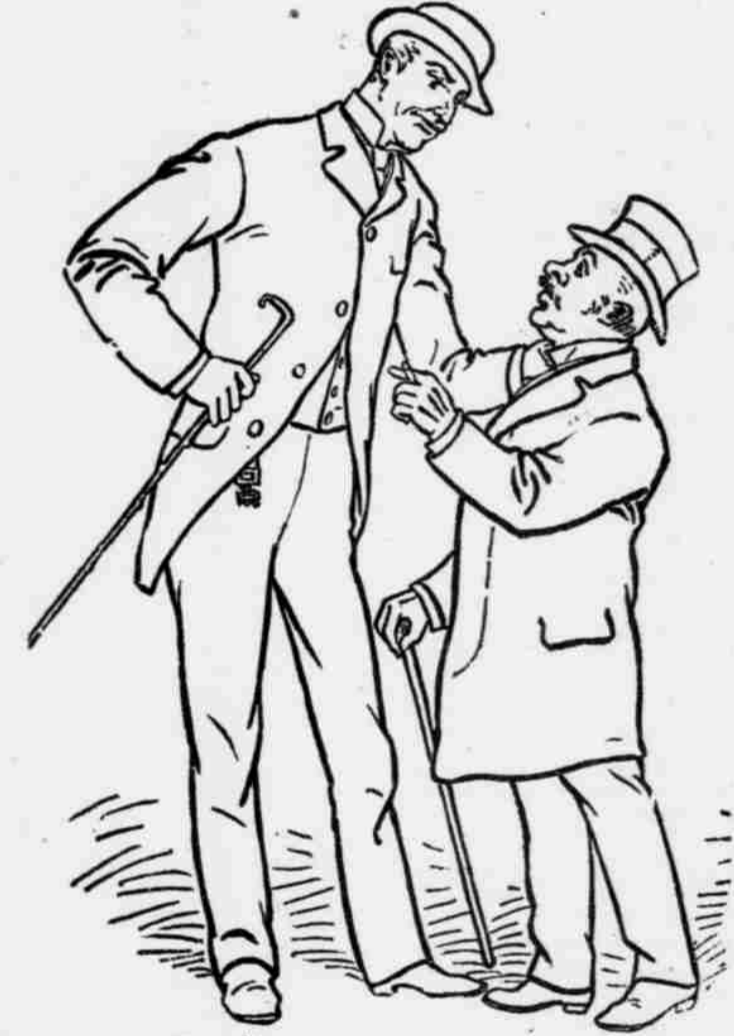
