Washington, June 6 .- A telegram was received at the treasury department to-day, announcing that the revenue steamer Richard Rush sailed from San Francisco to-day for a cruise to Ounalaska and the Seal Islands, for the protection of the : eal fisheries. It is stated at the department that the instructions to Capt. Shepard, her commanding officer, were substantially the same as those previously sent to Capt. Healy, commanding the revenue steamer Bear, which is now cruising in Alaskan waters, The orders to Captain Healy made no reference whatever to the treatment of foreign vessels found fishing in the vicinity of Seal Islands. An officer of the department said to-day that the course to be pursued in cases of alleged foreign invasion of our fishery rights will depend almost entirely upon the circumstances surrounding the case, and action will be left to the discretion of the commanding officer of the revenue






