The Moon and the Weather. Some Scientific Facts Regarding an Old Superstition. Adam Forepaugh sat on a nail keg on the elevated seats. 'Chicago?' said he; 'why, Chicago is the greatest show town in the world—and then the moon; why, we've got another week of the change.'

China, with its dependencies, has an area of over four million square miles, or much more than the entire area of the United States, which is not quite three millions. 'But,' people are heard to say, 'as the moon influences the tides, why should it not affect the atmosphere too?'

Two minutes' study of a celestial globe will show how variable is the inclination of the ecliptic to the horizon, and consequently that of the line joining the cusps of the moon also. Finally, the most elaborate comparison of meteorological records made in England and in England (where the Greenwich observations were carefully collected for forty years were correlated with the moon's phases during that period) have shown that no connection whatever exists between them.
