Women as Ranch Owners.

It is interesting to know that among the occupations which are open to women the hard life of ranching has been one in which she has been particularly successful. When she became the wife of an army officer she learned the valuable lesson of adapting herself to circumstances. In this way she received an education which was to fit her to become one of the most successful ranch owners of the southwest, when, on he death of her husband, she found herself alone in the world, with a modest capital. There is no suggestion in the wholesome, robust, successful ranchwoman of that delcate hothouse flower which was the picture of her first youth .-Boston Post.


