A Life Sentence.
SALEM, June 22.—W. W. Saunders was this morning sentenced by Judge Boise to imprisonment in the penitentiary for life, his attorneys having decided to accept the verdict of the jury and not to make a motion for a new trial. Saunders appeared considerably dejected, and bore up well under the sentence, having evidently made up his mind to submit calmly to the worst. When asked if he had anything to say, he said to the judge: "I believe you have no discretion in the matter of sentence;" and Judge Boise answered; "I have not," whereupon Saunders rejoined: "Under the circumstances I have nothing to say," and sentence was passed. Saunders manifested no noticeable emotion until he separated from the sheriff and deputy at the penitentiary, whither he was taken in the afternoon. Then he broke completely down.


