Cushings Court Street Assessment. NOTICE is hereby given that the assessment made by ordinance No. 588, of the city of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, entitled an ordinance declaring the probable cost of improving Cushings Court street from West 8th to West 9th street, which passed the common council of said city on the 28th day of July, 1887, and was approved by the mayor of said city on the 1st day of August, 1887, for the improvement of Cushings Court street in said city, as laid out and recorded by J. M. Shively, from its intersection with West 8th street to its intersection with West Ninth street in the manner provided by ordinance No. 589 of said city, entitled "an ordinance declaring the time and manner of improving Cushings Court street from West 8th to West 9th street," which ordinance passed the common council of said city on the 21st day of June, 1887, and was approved by the said mayor on the 28th day of June, 1887, on each of the following described lots fronting on said portion of said street, is now due and payable at the office of the city treasurer, in U.
