A Bloody Affair.

CHEHALIS, W. T., Aug. 29.—The cutting and shooting affray that occurred at Oloqua last night resulted in the death of three of the parties engaged. Some were shot and some were cut up so they died in a few minutes. It started over a game of poker. There were six men playing, five quarter breeds and one white man, who claimed to be a detective from Cincinnati. One half breed got to cutting up and the others wanted the detective to arrest him, but he would not submit to arrest and the detective shot him. Then two of these got hold of the detective, and nearly severed his head from his body with knives. Only one man escaped unhurt, two men are expected to die every minute. No names have been found out yet. They were nearly all drunk.

ASTORIA MUNICIPAL BONDS.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE City of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, has recalled and will redeem the following Municipal Bonds of said city, at the First National Bank of Astoria, Oregon, on and after September 5th, 1887.

The following are the Bonds recalled: Bonds issued by virtue of Ordinance No. 301, entitled "an ordinance authorizing the issuing of certain bonds to meet the outstanding indebtedness of the City of Astoria, and providing the time and manner of paying the same," approved June 18th, 1887, and ordinance No. 305, amended thereof, entitled "An ordinance to amend section 1 of an ordinance entitled 'an ordinance authorizing the issuing of certain bonds to meet the outstanding indebtedness of the City of Astoria and providing the time and manner of paying the same,' approved July 23d, 1879, being as follows: Bonds numbered from 1 to 20 inclusive for \$500.00 each, Bonds numbered from 1 to 10 inclusive for \$1000.00 each, Bonds numbered from 1 to 2 inclusive for \$200.00 each, all of which Bonds are dated July 1st, 1879, and payable on or before ten years after date, and bear interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum, interest payable semi-annually.

Also Bonds issued by virtue of Ordinance No. 443, entitled "An ordinance authorizing the issuing of City Bonds to meet the outstanding indebtedness of the City of Astoria, over and above that covered by bonds heretofore issued, to provide funds for carrying on the city government until such time as the tax for the year 1882 shall be available for municipal purposes, and to provide for the time and manner of paying the same," approved January 26th, 1882, being bonds numbered from 1 to 200 inclusive, for \$500.00 each, dated March 1st, 1882, payable on or before ten years after date, and bearing interest at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, interest payable semi-annually.
