The ship Merom, Capt. Glover, is loading lumber at Montgomery & Colwell's mill. She will carry about 1,000,000 feet. The stevedores are putting in about 6,000 to the man, and on Saturday put in about 48,000 feet. The price paid by the ship is \$1.50 per thousand, while on Puget sound it costs only \$1 per thousand. At this rate the men loading are earning \$9 each, and only work nine hours per day. If done no faster it will take between three and four weeks to get the Merom's cargo on board. Mr. Colwell, one of the partners of the mill, has been argely in the transportation business on the lakes as well as in the manufacture of lumber. He told a man in the hearing of our correspondent that he has loaded on one of his steam propellers in ten hours 200,000 feet, and it was not considered anything to boast

The new steam schooner is progressing finely. The ribs are nearly all up and planking will soon begin. The ribs are 8x10 inches, placed in pairs, and set two feet apart with inch packing. Between the packing the aper-tures will be filled with rock salt to preserve the wood. For the same sized ships in the east ribs of oak are used, but they are only Patronize Home Industry! 6x14 inches. By tests made at the Mare Island navy yard our Oregon pine has been proven to have the tensile strength of oak. feet. Such was the toughness and elasticity of this tree that when dragging it into the water it was allowed to rest on each end in crossing a depression, making a curve of nine feet without pro ducing a fracture. It has been greatly admired by hundreds of visitors. - Oregonian, 6.

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 5 .- A remature explosion of 150 pounds lynamite occurred at the work on the sea wall extension, foot of Telegraph hill, this evening. Two dwelling houses in the vicinity were badly shattered, and Mrs Crowley, an occupant of one, slightly injured.
