POLITICAL

There is a call for a state convention at Boston, Mass., to nominate a full state labor ticket.

Gov. Larrabee of Iowa is being mentioned as a possible successor to United States senator Wilson.

Senator Hawley gives it as his opinion that Mr. Blaine is still undecided as to whether he ought to accept a renomination or not.

It is reported that a new Democratic illustrated paper is to be started in New York, and that Nast is to have charge of the caricature department.

Some of the Republican clerks in the war department talk of selling pools on the result of appointments to fill vacancies under the civil service rules.

There is a strong feeling in certain quarters that if Foraker carries Ohio by 30,000 he will immediately go to the front as a presidential candidate.

The German papers in Texas claim that the full German vote was first cast in the recent prohibition election, and that it reached at least 60,000.

Some of Henry George's adherents place the vote he will receive in New York for secretary of state at 100,000, while others are ready to predict 150,000, and the very sanguine 200,000.

The London News says that the extent of railway laid during the past fifty years has been in Europe, 130,000 miles; in North America, 170,000; in Mexico and South America, 15,000; in Asia, 20,000; in Africa, 5,000; and in Australia, 10,000.
