NEW YORK, Sept. 16 .- The election of directors of the Northern Pacific railroad company was a bloodless victory for both sides in the threatened contest. The present management was successful because the control was not wrested from it, and the opposition was satisfied because it had obtained a large representation in the board. A compromise ticket was selected without dissent. The vote was the largest in the company's history. A correspondence between Villard and C. B. Wright, of Philadelphia, just published indicates that peace between the Union and Northern Pacific roads is to be maintained by joint lease of the Oregon Railway & Navigation company's lines,

NEW YORK, Sept. 16.-After the election of the Northern Pacific directors yesterday Villard took the opportunity to shake hands with the other directors. He looked a trifle more gray and aged than when, in the full sense of his power, he drove the last spike on the Northern Pacific. But his financial downfall has left no lines on his face. He stood erect, and looked as little careworn as any young man in the room. He had made his millions, lost them all, and recovered them again in less time than most men would win their thousands. and every financier in the room at the election paid him deference.
