FACTS AND NEWS.

Twelve hundred divorces in St. Louis in one year. Buffalo gets its natural gas all the way from the Pennsylvania wells per pipe.

The first iron boat is said to have been built in 1777, on the river Foss, in Yorkshire. It was fifteen feet long and made of sheet iron.

The Bartlett pear is of English origin; it came to this country from Berkshire about eighty years ago, and was developed by Enoch Bartlett, of Dorchester, Mass.

The White Mountains have come to be worth over \$2,000,000 a year to the people of New Hampshire. In 1884 the tourist business in that section was scarcely \$15,000.

The eight longest rivers in the world, according to the calculations of Major General A. Von Tillo, are as follows: Missouri-Mississippi, 4,194; Nile, 4,020; Yang-tee-Kiang, 3,138; Amazon, 3,063; Yenesei-Seangna, 2,950; Amur, 2,950; Congo, 2,883; Mackenzie, 2,868.
